LEARN HOW TO REDUCE THE RISK OF EXPLOITATION IN CONGREGATE CARE

Join us for the first intensive online course designed specifically for congregate care settings seeking to create a safer and more engaging environment for commercially sexually exploited girls and/or girls at disproportionate risk. This highly interactive six-session online course is led by My Life My Choice trainers who will facilitate challenging, collaborative activities. Trainees will also hear first-hand from young survivors of CSEC as well as experts in the fields of congregate care, CSEC, and law enforcement- creating a holistic training experience that fosters lasting programmatic change.

➔ COURSE ATTENDEES WILL LEARN:

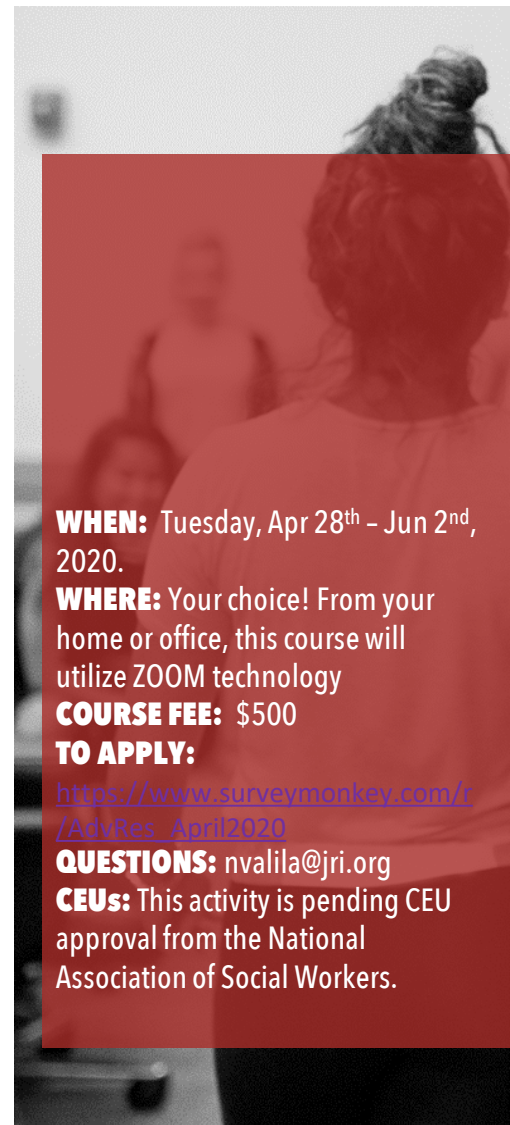
- To develop a comprehensive CSEC policy and protocols that align with best practices;
- To create a diverse, non-judgmental and engaging culture for improved outcomes for exploited and high risk youth;
- To develop trauma-informed programming specific to sexually exploited youth;
- To create and maintain a coordinated system of care; and
- Advanced skills and expertise around the trajectory of recovery from exploitation.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

The course is best suited for congregate care programs serving adolescent girls, which can include cisgender girls, transgender females, and transgender males whose experience of exploitation happened due to their gender identity or sex assigned at birth.

COURSE STRUCTURE

This six-week online course is comprised of six 75-minute live sessions with an expert trainer as well as up to 60-minutes of asynchronous content/assignments between each live session. The course is designed to encourage sharing current practices and experiences with different providers from across the country.
