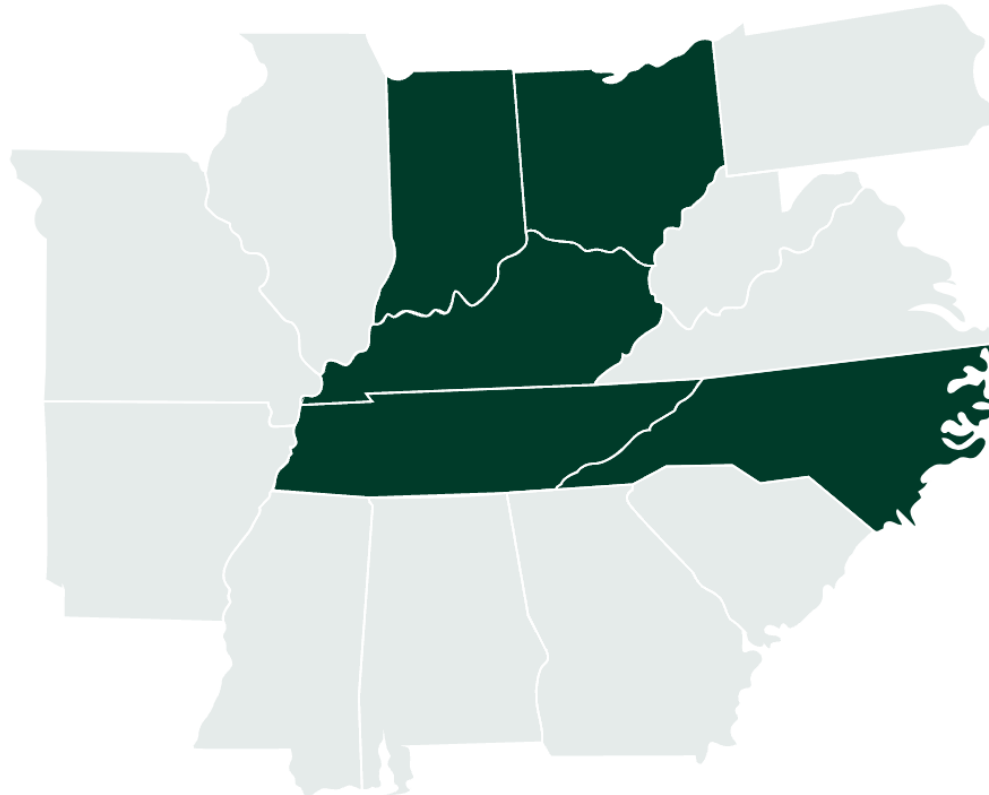

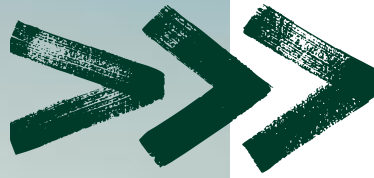

Our Approach to Whole Family Care

In Home Services are staffed with a therapist and Peer Family Specialist. Each family's unique culture and traditions are built into the plan. Services are designed around safety, permanency, and well-being for all family members.





Placement Stability Services

Designed with communities to stabilize youth with complex care needs in family/community settings.

Biological, Foster, Kinship, Adoptive and Re-entry from Juvenile Justice

Safety

- Home and community visits with children and caregivers
- Collaboration with JFS Staff
- Routine safety assessments
- Crisis Planning
- 24/7 Crisis Support
- In Home Stabilization

Permanency

- Concrete Needs Assistance
- Peer Family Specialists trained in Hope Science
- Attend Behavior platform for caregiver skills training
- Evidence Based practices (TBRI, Together Facing the Challenge, RUBI)

Wellbeing

- Trauma Informed Services
- Kinship Community Building monthly activities and outings
- Staff wellbeing resources to promote retention
- School engagement
- Med management services with rapid access*
- Individual and Family Therapy*

*Medicaid eligible services will be billed separately

Components of Care



An intensive **crisis** and **stabilization** program working with families *in their homes and community* to prevent and/or reduce risk of out-of-home placement



Time limited (90-day program) intensive therapeutic services with around the clock access to providers and on-call crisis line



An alternative to RTC, hospitalization, and foster home disruptions as well as a step-down service for youth returning home but still requiring an intensive level of care

Results



Problem Severity

Over 60% of families served reported improvement in problem severity.



Permanency

94% of kinship families served maintained placement.



Satisfaction

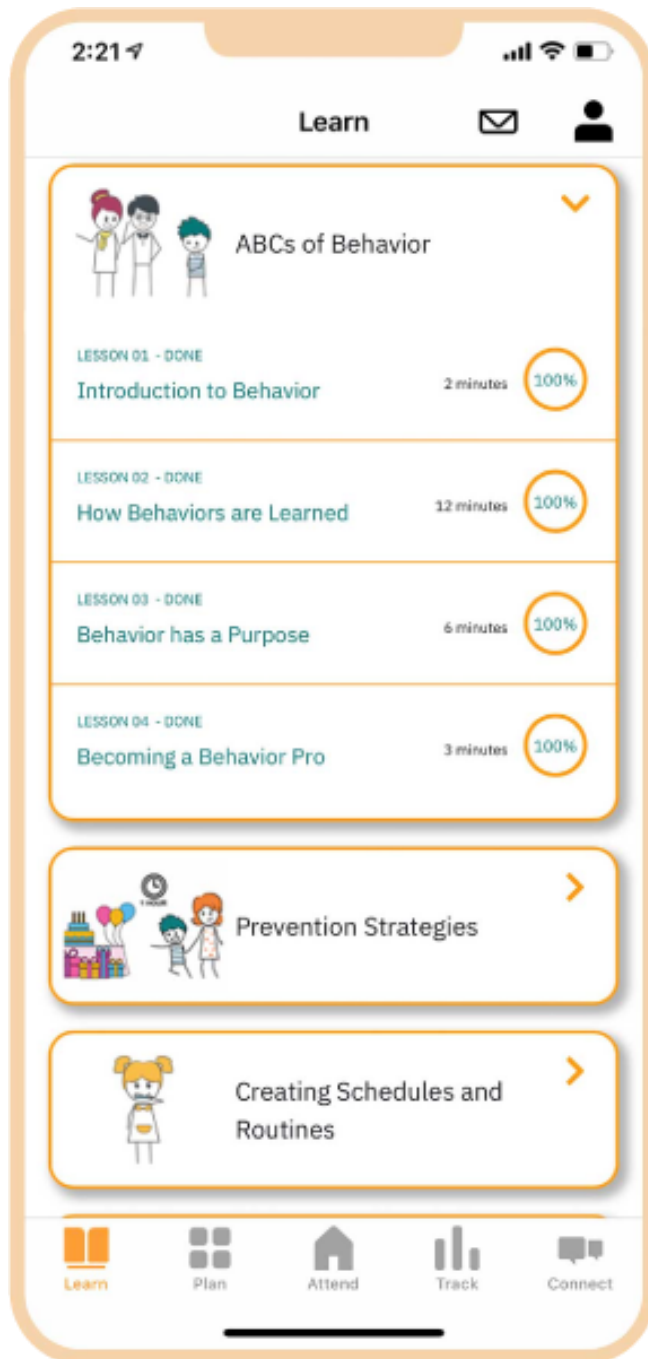
85% of youth enrolled in FITT did not utilize the emergency department while receiving services.

Evidence Based Practice

Clinical teams are trained in the Trust Based Relational Intervention (TBRI) model. TBRI focuses on healthy attachment and neuroscience to empower caregivers to meet the needs of the children in their care.

This model is recognized on both the California Evidence Based Clearinghouse and the Title IV_E Prevention Services Clearinghouse.
