Cultures of Respect: Re-Righting History, 1-day Workshop, July 15, 2026

Humans have biologically evolved to thrive in Cultures of Respect that meet the needs of both individuals and the group. In contrast, Cultures of Domination are marked by conflict and aggression. This one-day training is based on a new book by Martin Brokenleg and Larry Brendtro that blends Indigenous wisdom with Western science to explore how respectful cultures can be intentionally cultivated.
